The Loma Rica/Browns Valley Community Services District (District) supports the Yuba County – Loma Rica Road Pavement Rehabilitation Project. The project is located along Loma Rica Road, between the City of Marysville and the unincorporated communities of Iowa City, Loma Rica, Challenge, Brownsville, Challenge, Robbins, Clipper Mills, and Strawberry Valley. Loma Rica Road is a critical corridor in terms of primary access for our residents, an emergency response route, and a primary evacuation route in the event of wildfires.

The District is responsible for providing fire protection, first responder medical aid, and rescue assistance to the communities of Loma Rica and Browns Valley. Currently the District has a staff of two volunteers and is augmented by firefighters from the Cal-Fire. Together, they provide 24-hour, 7 day a week coverage. The District has three stations, one of which is located at 11485 Loma Rica Road. Our emergency responders depend on Loma Rica Road to respond to emergency calls throughout the foothills and our residents depend on Loma Rica Road as an emergency evacuation route in the event of wildfires. Therefore, the District fully supports the Yuba County – Loma Rica Road Pavement Rehabilitation Project.
